

GERALD LUBECK JUDGES 1984 SHOW

Gerald L. "Jerry" Lubeck, noted miniaturist and consistent award winner in his field, was selected by the Society to judge the Ninth International Miniature Art Show. Lubeck, a resident of North Pownal, Vermont, is a member of the Salmagundi Club, Allied Artists, Hudson Valley Art Association and the New Jersey Miniature Art Society.

His list of impressive credentials is dotted with numerous first place awards, including a "First in Oil" at the 1979 International Show here in Clearwater. He works in many mediums including oil, watercolor, acrylic and etching.

Lubeck's job as show judge presented a challenge of considerable magnitude he said as he began the review and selection of 44 awards in 20 categories from among the 700 works accepted by the Jury of Selection.
